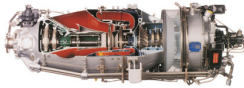




## What to do with an engine that falls in water?

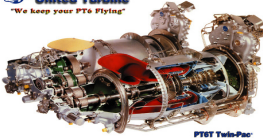
Pratt & Whitney Canada gives instructions to the overhaul shops on what to do when inspecting and repairing an engine that fell into water, but, what is the action to be taken by the operator in a situation like that to minimize collateral damages? These damages are directly related to corrosion of gears and bearings on the accessory and reduction gearbox.

Perhaps an aggressive action to dry and add anticorrosive agents to the interior of the affected modules could minimize the damages. Also it will be important to know how much time the operators have before an irreversible damage can be assessed.
